**FORMS** – We try to keep paperwork to a minimum, however there are times when we do need a paper return from you. We would be grateful if such returns are sent back promptly and also that both sides of the form are read so that all the information is returned. Thank you.

**BOOK FAIR** – The children will have a chance to look at the books in the Book Fair during Thursday & Friday 20 & 21 & may bring home a note indicating the books they like. You are under no obligation to purchase books but, if you would like them to buy a book you can send the money into school or come in yourself & see the books with your child on Friday 21, Monday 24 or Tuesday 25 from 3pm. The school gets commission on any books sold & we use this to buy new books for the library.

The children will be involved in a 'blurb' competition writing about their favourite books. These will be displayed in the library. There will be a prize for the best 'blurb' in each class & the winning child in each class will have the opportunity to choose a book from the book fair.

**UNIVERSAL FREE SCHOOL MEALS** – We are aware that not all KS1 or Reception children take up their entitlement and we would encourage them to do so. Even if they are a fussy eater we know that if they see others eating dinner this encourages them to try different things & after a couple of weeks, very often, they are happily eating well at school. This also makes a considerable saving for parents over the course of the year & is therefore worth taking up for this reason.

**FREE SCHOOL MEALS** - If you think your child/ren may be eligible for benefits lead free schools meals (this also applies to children in Reception, Y1 & Y2), please go to the Cornwall Council website- Education & Learning - Apply for free school meals and complete the application form. Or send in your date of birth and national insurance number and we will check for you. Children who qualify for free schools meals receive an additional £1300 funding which allows us to maintain staff levels and additional support.

**CLUBS** – Your children will bring home a clubs letter which you will need to return to school next week. Clubs will start w/b 24 September. A clubs list will be published next Friday so that you can see which clubs your children have a place on. We try to ensure that all children have at least one club & other places are allocated on a first come first served basis.
