INTERNET SAFETY & GAMING – It concerns us that we are hearing increasingly from children across the school about their participation in online games and in playing games that are very age inappropriate. When we look at some of the rough behaviour exhibited by some children in the playground we can't help but feeling that some of it is attributable to the type of aggressive, competitive games that some children play on the computers. We wish to raise parental awareness of our concerns and encourage parents to be super vigilant when their children are playing games and also encourage the setting of tight parental controls.

Safeguarding our children from harm and supporting their wellbeing is key to our working life in school and unsupervised online access and playing of age inappropriate games is a significant safeguarding concern.

PUPIL PREMIUM FUNDING FOR SCHOOL- Could your child be eligible for additional funding to help school to provide teaching assistant support in class?

If you are in receipt of any of the following benefits.

- Income Support (IS)
- Job Seekers' Allowance (Income-Based) and equal based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance (ESA-IR) and equal based Employment and Support Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit (CTC) with an annual income of less than £16,190.
- Working Tax Credit run-on - paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit
- Guarantee Element of Pension Credit (GPC)
- Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (IAA) Support
- Universal Credit - if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get) as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods

Your child may be entitled to additional funding in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 and additional funding plus a free school meal in Y3, 4, 5 & 6

If your application is successful, your child's/children's entitlement will continue until the end of their school life or until you cease to be eligible – whichever is first. There is no longer a need for claims to be renewed annually.

The additional funding allows us to provide additional support in class, financial support towards school trips and events and as and when bursaries to support specific need. It makes a significant contribution to the support we are able to give to children in school.

Or send your Name, National Insurance Number & Date of Birth into school and we will check for you.

Please note that anyone claiming **Working Tax Credit**, Contribution-Based Job Seeker's Allowance and/or Contribution-Based Employment and Support Allowance is **NOT** eligible regardless of what other benefits/credits are being claimed. However, you will be temporarily eligible to claim free school meals if you receive a Working Tax Credit run-on, which is the payment someone may receive for a further four weeks after they stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit.

Applications will be processed within three working days of receipt. We will notify you of the outcome in writing of the date your Free School Meals will start. Please note that we are unable to backdate any claim.

As the eligibility criteria for free school meals is determined by Central Government, not Local Government; as such, there is no appeal process for free school meals
