Welcome back to school and a happy new year for 2019. The staff would like to thank everyone for the cards and gifts they received over the Christmas period, very much appreciated.

**READING** – Starting next week we are introducing a reward system to encourage children to read at home on a regular basis. The rewards will run half termly. Any child who reads 10 times will receive a bronze badge, 20 times a silver badge and 30 times a gold badge. The children will trade their badges for the next colour up. The children winning their badges will have the achievements celebrated in assembly on Friday afternoons. At the end of half term assembly the gold badge winners will all receive a prize and have their names entered in a raffle to win a £10 book token.

When children read at home it must be signed by an adult to confirm that they have read for a minimum of 10 minutes. This reading does not necessarily have to be their school book but can be a home or library book.

We need children to be good readers and also want to improve their vocabularies and their enthusiasm for reading. PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT!
